FACTS	WHAT DOES TRUST COMPANY OF AMERICA DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. The types of information we collect and share can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and income • Assets and transaction history • Account balances and investment experience When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Trust Company of America chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Trust Company of America protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Trust Company of America collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or give us your account information • Make deposits or withdrawals from your account • Show your driver's license or government-issued ID

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Trust Company of America affiliates include TCAdvisor Network inc., TCA Financial, Inc. and Gemisys, Inc., however, Trust Company of America does not share with affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Trust Company of America does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Trust Company of America does not jointly market.</i>
