What Does United Bank & Trust Do With Your Personal Information?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number, name, address, and income
- Account balances, payment history, and overdraft history
- Credit history and credit worthiness

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share clients' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their clients' personal information; the reasons United Bank & Trust chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 Our affiliates include United Bank & Trust, United Bank & Trust – Insurance Agency, and United Structured Finance Company
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	 United Bank & Trust does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	 Our joint marketing partners include companies such as credit card providers
