How does UNFCU protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</li> <li>sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> <li>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</li> </ul>		
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Affiliates	<ul> <li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Our affiliates include UNFCU Financial Service LLC dba Industrial Coverage Corporation (ICC), UNFCU Advisors LLC.</li> </ul>		
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Non affiliates we share with can include non profit organizations, direct marketing companies, and insurance companies.</li> </ul>		
Joint marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our joint marketing partners include investment, insurance and other financial services companies.</li> </ul>
