

## WHAT DOES WELLESLEY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL **FACTS INFORMATION?** Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do. What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and income Account balances and payment history Credit history and credit scores When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice. How? All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Wellesley Bank chooses to share; and whether you

can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Wellesley Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
	We also maintain other physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal and state regulatory standards.
How does Wellesley Bank collect my personal information?	<ul> <li>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</li> <li>Open an account or pay us by check</li> <li>Show your driver's license or give us your income information</li> <li>Give us your contact information</li> </ul> We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only  Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness  Affiliates from using your information to market to you  Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you  State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • Our affiliates include financial companies such as Wellesley Investment Partners, LLC.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.  • Wellesley Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  • Our joint marketing partners include the credit card company that provides our jointly branded card.

Wellesley Bank has established standards and practices to ensure compliance with provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 93H relative to the safeguarding of personal information contained in both paper and electronic records for residents of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
