WHAT DOES WEST VIEW SAVINGS BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- · Social Security number and income
- · Account balances and payment history
- · Credit history and credit scores.

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons West View Savings Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does West View Savings Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.	
How does West View Savings Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you open an account or deposit money pay your bills or apply for a loan use your credit or debit card We also collect your personal information from other companies. Why can't I limit all sharing? Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • We do not share with affiliates	
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • We do not share with nonaffiliates	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. We may disclose all of the information we collect, as described above, to companies that perform marketing services on our behalf or to other financial institutions with whom we have joint marketing agreements. The non affiliated third parties we have contracted with regarding this are: Credit card companies used for providing West View Savings Bank credit cards to a customer. Credit Life and Accident Health Insurance companies used for providing insurance to West View Savings Bank loan customers. We may also disclose nonpublic personal information about you to non-affiliated third parties as permitted by law.

	Closing your account with us. If you decide to close your account (s) or become an inactive customer, we will follow the privacy policies and practices described in this Notice until your nonpublic personal information has been purged from our files. Contracting with Third Parties. We may contract with other entities to perform specific support services such as, but not limited to, data processing, that may require us to provide them access to our customer information. When doing so, we require such third party service providers to contractually agree to adhere to our security and privacy guidelines. Notice not a Contract.
