What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: I Social Security number I Credit scores I Transaction or loss history I Account transactions I Credit history I Wire transfer instructions When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.				
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Winchester Co-Operative Bank has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Winchester Co-Operative Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Winchester Co-Operative Bank doesn't jointly market.

For Massachusetts Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with

nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing - without your authorization. Winchester Co-Operative Bank complies with Massachusetts Information Privacy Laws.
