

FACTS	WHAT DOES WINTER HILL BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?		
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: • Social Security		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Winter Hill Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do

How does Winter Hill Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We limit access to your personal information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Winter Hill Bank has no affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Winter Hill Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial
