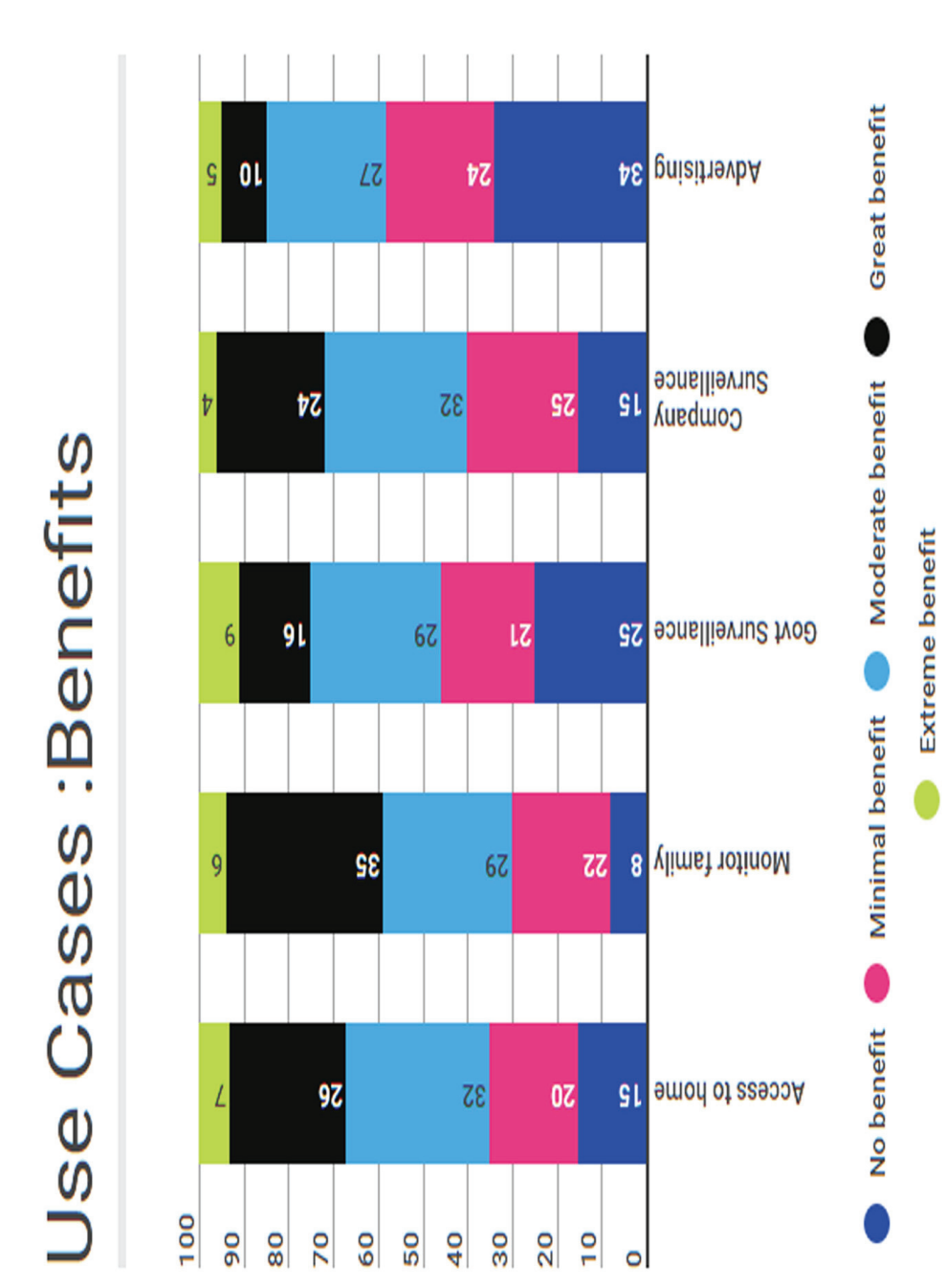
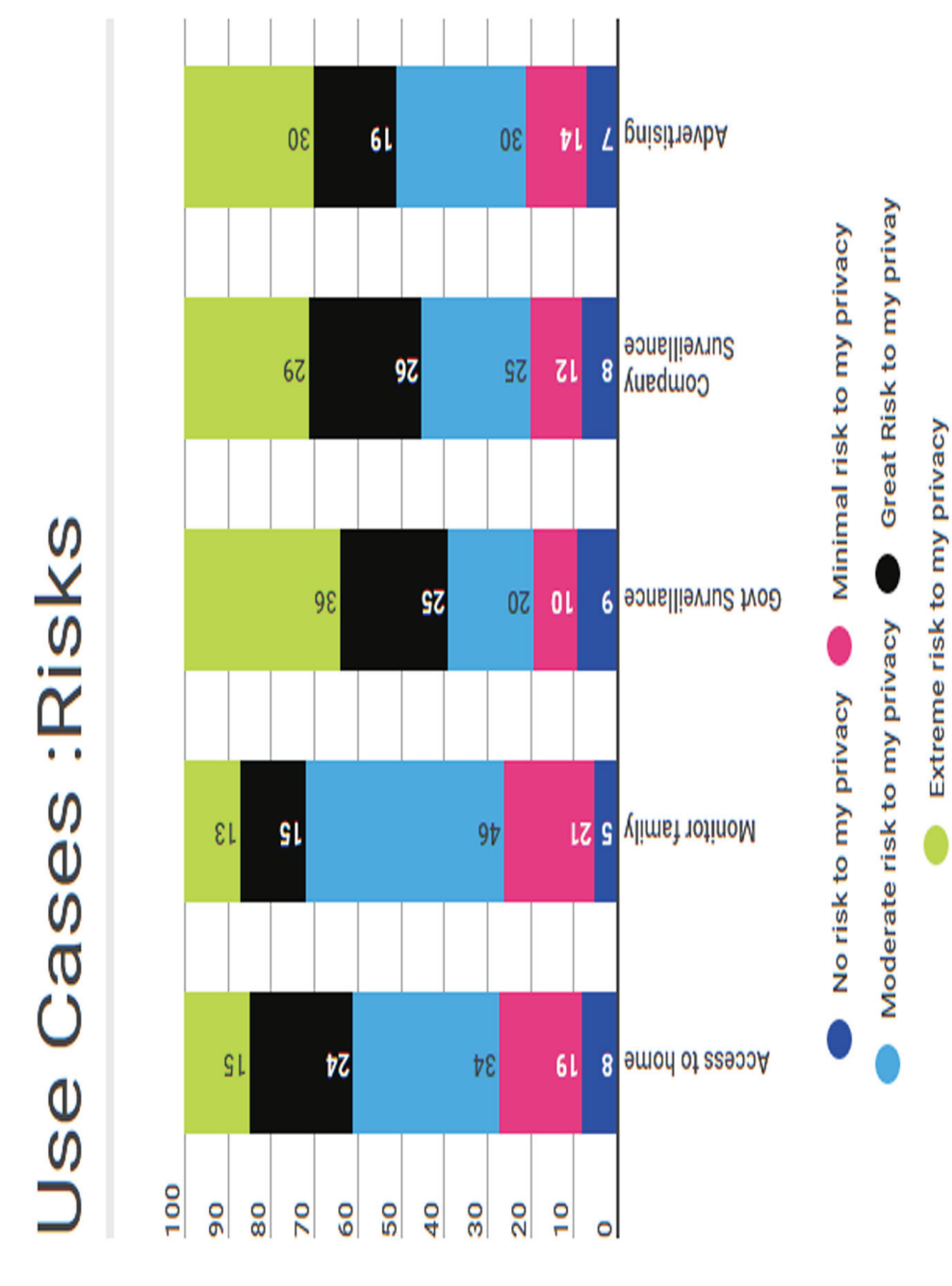

Scores reflecting global privacy concerns were not the greatest predictors of how much benefit and risk people perceived for home IoT devices.

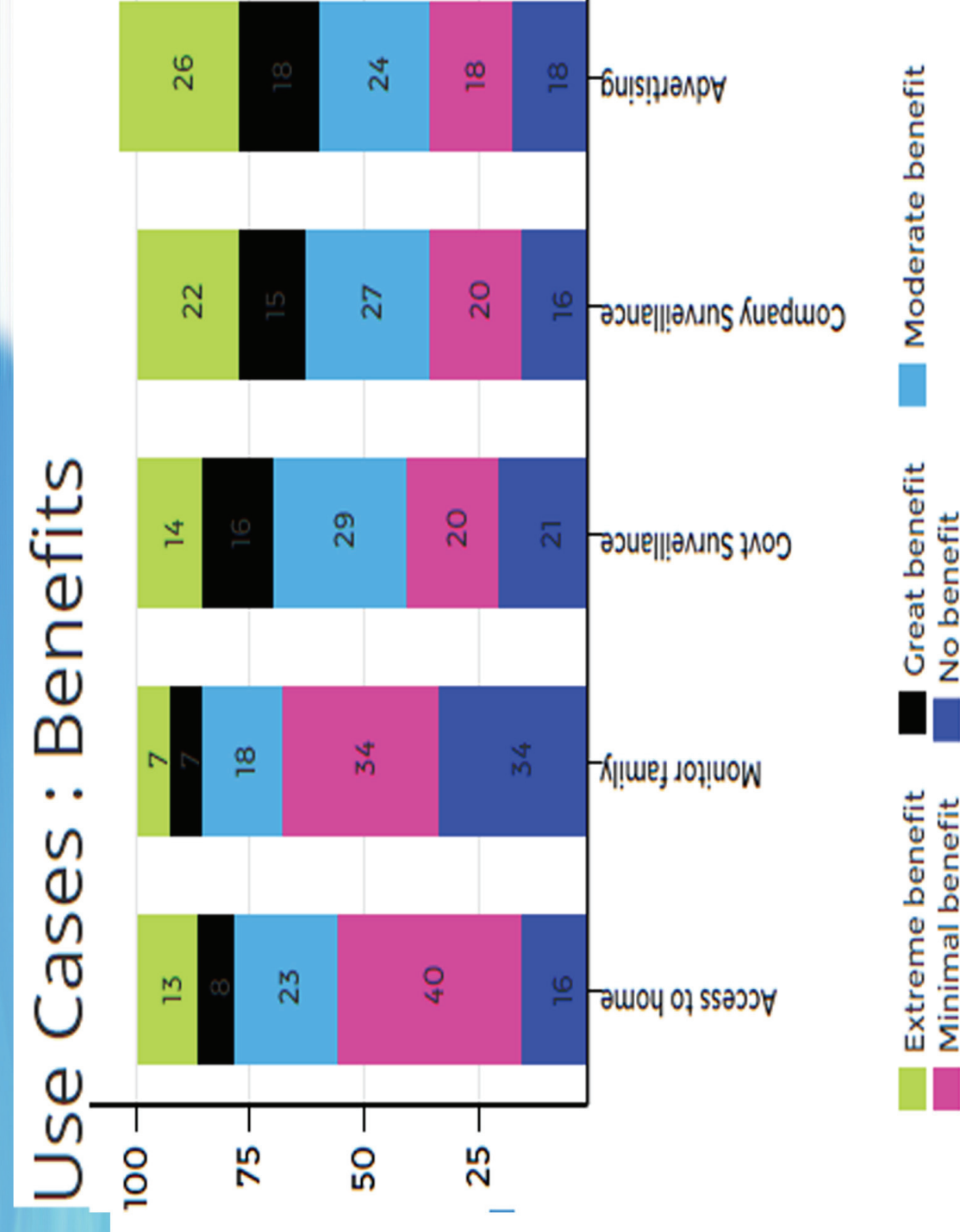
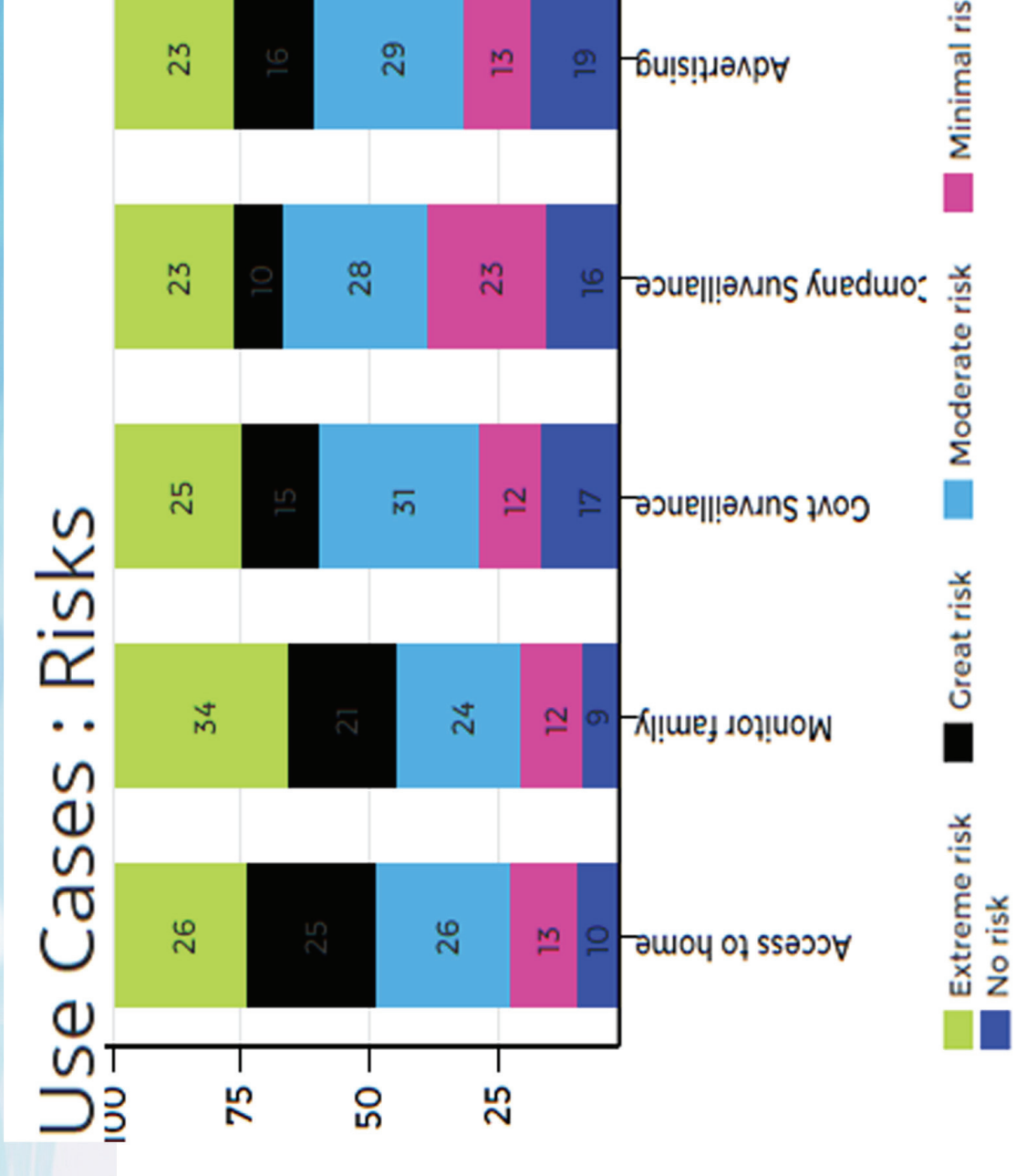
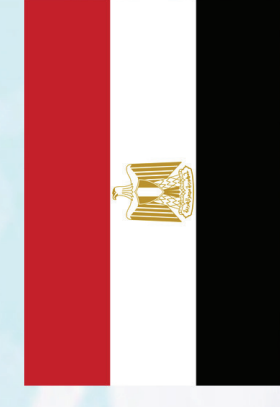
Extent of privacy regulation in a country did not necessarily predict perceptions of benefits and risks.

People from countries with greater government surveillance often perceived greater benefits and less privacy risk, compared to people from countries with less government surveillance.

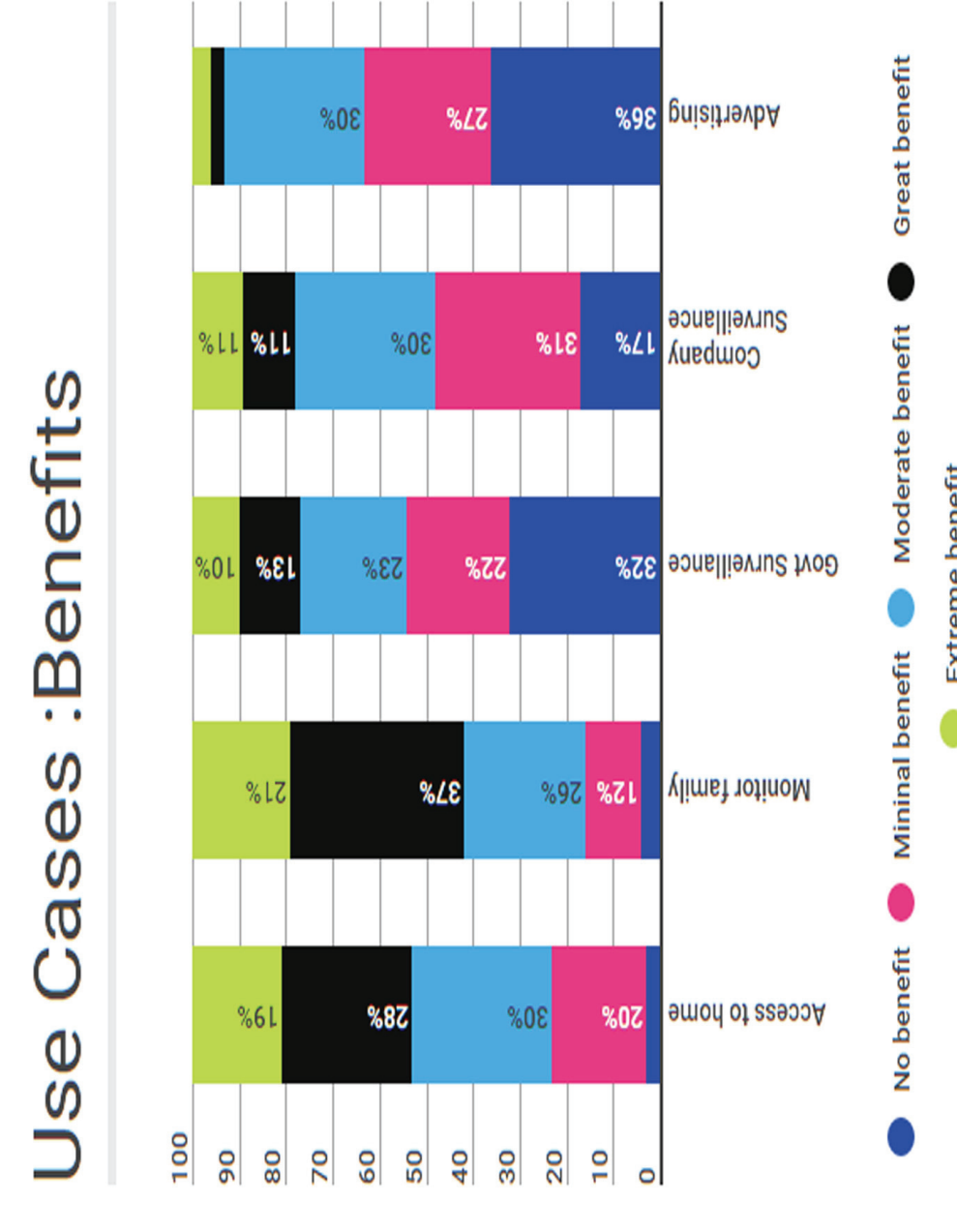
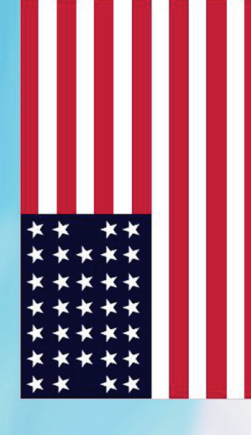
